## Inmate Profile Summary

This report summarizes county information mandated to be collected by F.S. § 951.23(2) and submitted to Florida Department of Corrections. It provides a monthly profile of inmate populations inside Florida's detention facilities. For counties that can not submit data using standardized instruments it provides approximated data.

Table 1, pages 1 & 2, features the Average Daily Population and incarceration rate in each county.

Table 2, pages 3 & 4, lists the number and percent of felony and misdemeanor pretrial inmates at each detention facility.

The Jail Population Summary (Table 3, page 5) lists detention center totals for the year to date.

### **Average Daily Population**

As reported, there were an estimated 56,945 inmates in Florida's county detention facilities during the month of October 2018. In comparison, in October 2017, there were 53,525 inmates incarcerated by county facilities in Florida. This is a 6.4% increase from last year.
