Your Affiant is Law Enforcement Inspector Maria Fender with the Office of Inspector General - FDC.

On July 6, 2019, at Wakulla Correctional Institution (WCI) in Crawfordville, Florida, the above-named defendant; Officer Zachary T. Swain, knowingly and with intent, committed the criminal offense of: Official Misconduct (one count), contrary to Florida Statute §838.022. Officer Swain (a public servant), conspired to conceal a Report of Force Used on an inmate and knowingly gave false information to Inspector Maria Fender during his sworn interview (see below). Cause exists to believe Officer Swain's actions were carried out to: deceive, omit, obstruct and delay, minimize, or deny him detailing his direct involvement in a Use of Force (UOF) applied by him on Inmate Otis Brown, DC# 166013.

On July 6, 2019, Officer Swain was escorting Inmate Brown through the L-Dorm side one sally port when a reactionary UOF ensued. Inmate Brown's hands were restrained behind his back during the entirety of the event. Officer Reneccia Brown was assigned in the Officer Station and having observed a UOF taking place, notified Captain Travis Asbell that Officer Swain needed assistance. As Captain Asbell arrived in the L-Dorm sally port, he testified he observed Officer Swain holding Inmate Brown in a guillotine choke hold. Captain Asbell grabbed Inmate Brown's shoulder and directed him to the ground. Sergeant Samantha O'Neal and Officer Christopher Elias responded to the sally port to assist Captain Asbell and Officer Swain in securing Inmate Brown.

Following the UOF, Captain Asbell and Officer Swain spoke of not reporting the incident due to it not being on camera and agreed the UOF would go unreported.

In his sworn, digitally recorded post Miranda interview conducted at WCI by Inspector Maria Fender, Officer Swain testified to the following which was found to be false:

Officer Swain stated he made numerous attempts to advise Captain Asbell he did not agree with the decision to "sweep this under the rug." This testimony is in direct conflict with the sworn statement of Captain Asbell who stated Officer Swain never advised him at any time following the incident, he was not in support of the decision to not report the UOF. Captain Asbell's testimony is supported by later testimony from Officer Swain, who he himself stated, Captain Asbell never said anything else to him about this incident.

Officer Swain testified he spoke with Lieutenant Natavia Gallagher on July 6, 2019 following Captain Asbell's refusal to report the UOF, in hopes she would speak to Captain Asbell and convince him to report the incident. In Lieutenant Gallagher's sworn statement, she testified, Officer Swain never approached her or contacted her about an unreported UOF.

Officer Swain testified he was unaware of there being two separate incident reports detailing different versions of the UOF incident despite his testimony he had asked Officer Janece Parker to write one for him and later had to go back and write his own. Officer Swain stated he told Officer Parker what to write and he was "trying to cover his butt".

Officer Swain's testimony is further discredited by the incident reports of Sergeant Samantha O'Neal and Officer Janece Parker's sworn testimony in which both state, Officer Swain advised Inmate Brown became disorderly and attempted to lay down, which is an incorrect account of the events.

Your affiant respectfully submits, probable cause has been established in that, Officer Swain committed the criminal violation(s) of; Official Misconduct, in violation of §838.022 Florida State Statute, in Wakulla County, Crawfordville, Florida.
