Your Affiant, Inspector Greg Fulcher, is a sworn law enforcement officer of the Office of the Inspector General, Florida Department of Corrections.								
On February 6, 2020, at Desoto Correctional Institution Annex, Arcadia, Florida, Desoto County, the above-named defendant, Mr. David Rector born did violate Florida State Statutes, committing the criminal offenses of: Introduction and possession of unlawful articles in a correctional facility; by knowingly and intentionally, introduced 30 cigarettes containing tobacco or unknown tobacco substance into Desoto Correctional institution Annex (Cl) (1 Count), and Commercial bribe receiving; by receiving monetary payment for introduced illicit items or contraband; by knowingly and intentionally accepting payment for the introduction of tobacco substances brought to an inmate within Desoto Cl (1 Count) (F.S.S. 944.47(1)(a)(1) and 838.15 (1)(a)). The defendant, Rector, had concealed on his person 30 cigarettes containing an unknown substance (possible tobacco) inside his pants. Rector received approximately \$200.00 for bringing in similar items on four separate occasions into Desoto Correctional Institution (C.I.)., where Rector is employed. Rector was to receive \$50.00 upon successful delivery of the items today (February 6, 2020).
