NOTICE OF DISPOSITION OF DECLARATORY STATEMENT

FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Florida Department of Corrections issued a Final Order dated April 6, 2018, disposing of the Petition for Declaratory Statement filed on February 19, 2018, by inmate Edward Wilson, DC# 079099 regarding 33-602.204, F.A.C., and seeking “clarification of [the] rule governing strip-searching of the inmates housed at Okeechobee Work Camp, and other institutions within the Florida Department of Corrections.”

The following is a summary of the agency’s disposition of the petition: As an inmate of the Florida Department of Corrections, Edward Wilson, DC# 079099, may only participate in administrative proceedings that are brought pursuant to sections 120.54(3)(c) and (7), Florida Statutes. Pursuant to Section 120.81(3), Florida Statutes, the Petitioner lacks standing to bring a Petition for Declaratory Statement, and the Department lacks jurisdiction to issue a declaratory statement in this case.
