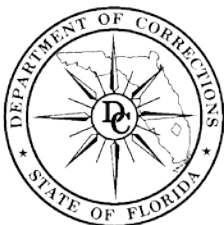

Community Supervision Offender Population Summary

This Monthly Status Report provides a brief profile of Florida's community supervision population. The supervision population consists of all offenders on supervision through specific court placement or other assignment to a community-based program as a condition of prison release. The overall population on the last day of the month is broken down into status types:

- Active - offender is currently supervised in the community per conditions of supervision
- Active-Suspense - offender is unavailable for direct supervision, may be incarcerated, hospital, etc., during supervision term, but is still monitored by a probation officer
- Out of State - Florida offender transfers supervision to another state, the Department of Corrections continues to monitor compliance of conditions
- Absconder - offender absconds from supervision, whereabouts are unknown and court issues a warrant for violation

Supervision types are divided into Original Sentence, Post Prison Release and Other Supervision Types. These represent the actual types of supervision imposed by the court or the Parole Commission. As of September 30, 2009:

- 156,706 offenders on Active or Active-Suspense Community Supervision
 - 151,430 serving an original sentence
 - 5,270 on Post-Prison Release
 - 5 on other types of supervision
 - 1 Unknown supervision type
- 2,412 Offenders on electronic monitoring
 - 88 Radio Frequency
 - 2,345 Active Global Positioning
 - 1,114 Global Positioning under Jessica Lunsford Act
 - 1,231 Other Global Positioning
- Region II has the highest active supervised population with 32,334 offenders
- The average Probation sentence is 3.7 years (includes life sentences)

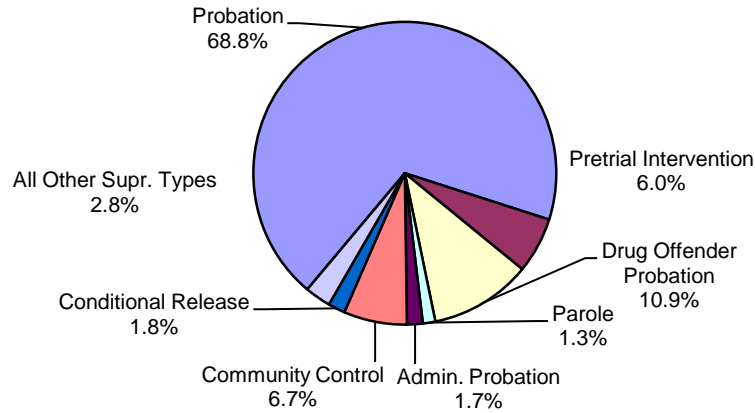

Budget Entity Category

The upcoming charts detail the following supervision categories, which are based on budget allocations provided by the Legislature. These categories are mutually exclusive and have been ranked in the order listed below:

- Community Control, including Sex Offender Community Control
- Sex Offender & Post Prison, including Sex Offender Probation, offenders falling under the Public Safety Information Act (PSIA)* and Sexual Predators; and Post Prison, including Parole, Conditional Release, Control Release, and Provisional Release
- Drug Offender Probation
- Pretrial Intervention including Drug Offender Pretrial Intervention
- Probation, including Felony, Misdemeanor and Administrative Probation, and youthful offenders.

These supervision groupings reflect the allocation of officers necessary to meet the needs of specialized caseloads. For example, the ratio of officer to offenders needs to be lower for specialized caseloads of community control and sex offenders than it does for probation or administrative cases.

However, while these groupings provide an accurate picture of the types of offenders that are on supervision, the numbers in this chart may not match those published in the previous section of this report. For example, Table 9: Budget Entity by Region/Circuit (Active Offenders) lists the number of probationers on supervision as 79,146. The previous section lists this number as 81,275 (probation and administrative probation) which is the correct number of offenders on this type of supervision. However, of the 81,533 probationers, 2,129 are sex offenders. Therefore, in this section, these offenders appear in this category rather than "Probation."

Note: There are 487 post-prison sex offenders listed in the Sex Offender Budget Entity (390 active, 97 active-suspense) and 504 sex offenders in the Community Control Budget Entity (324 active, 180 active-suspense).

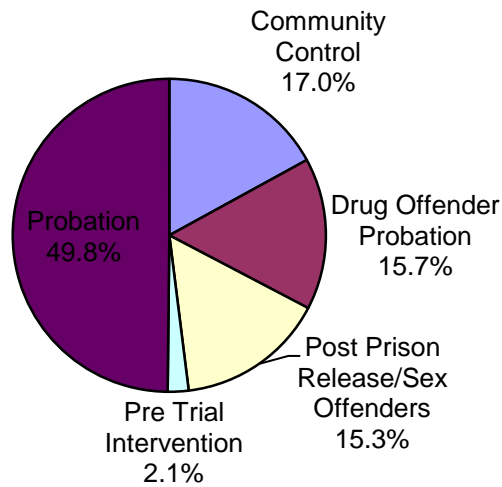

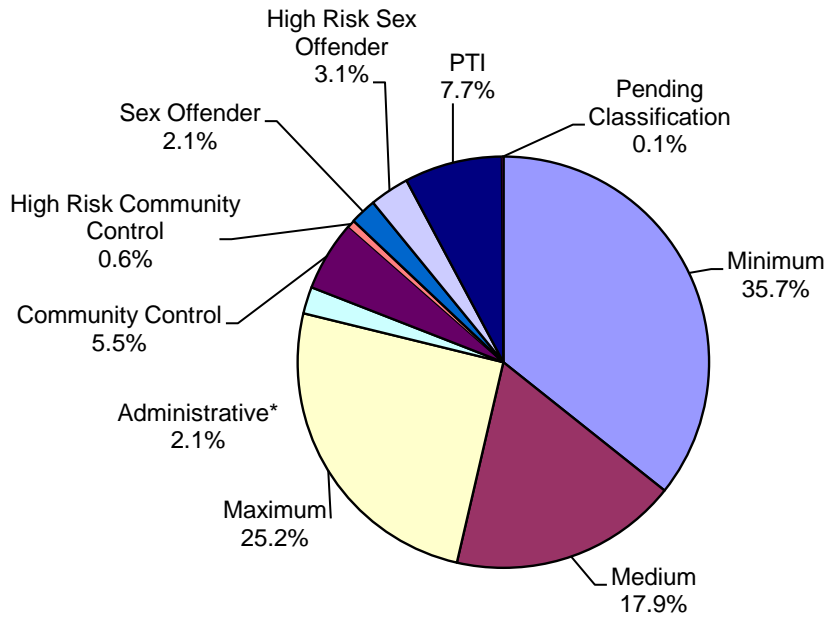

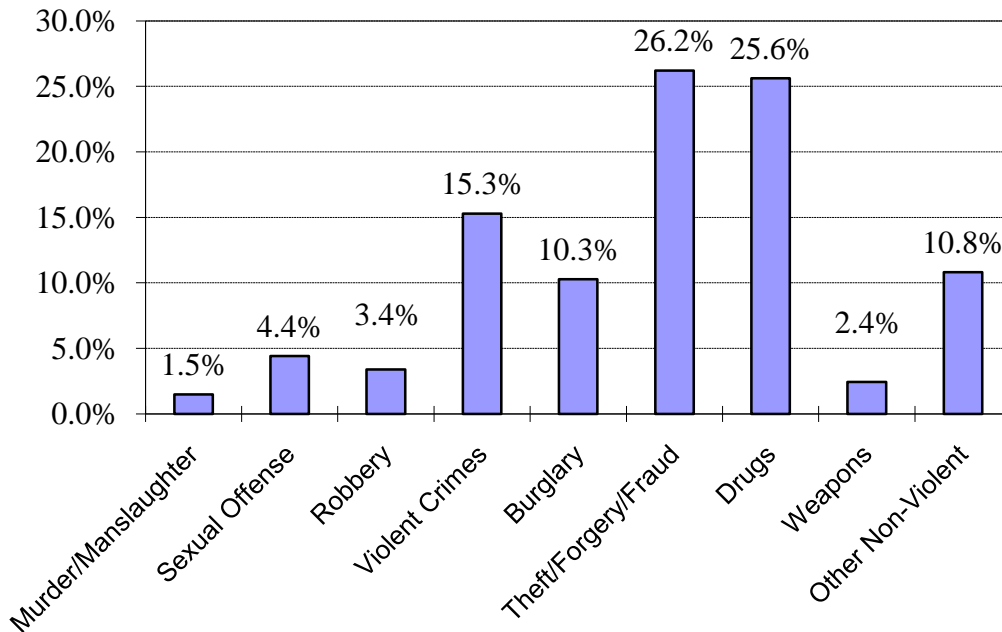

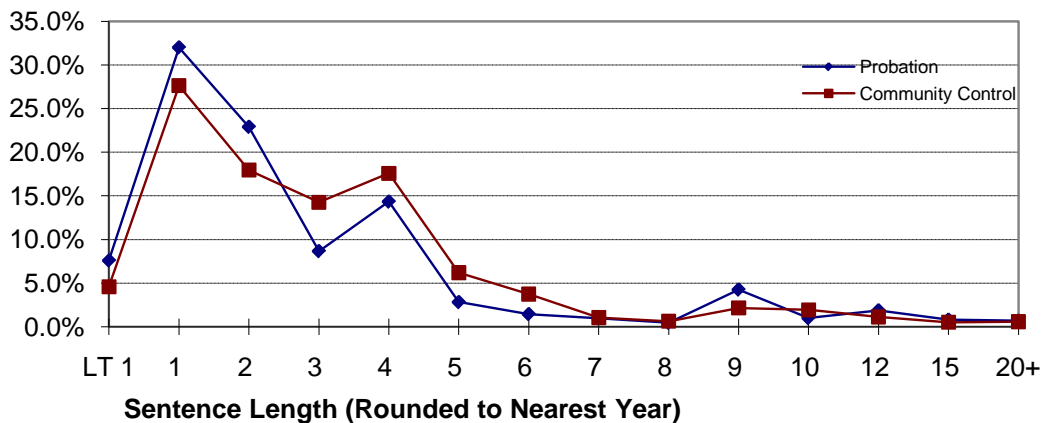

Chart 6: Prior Supervision Commitments

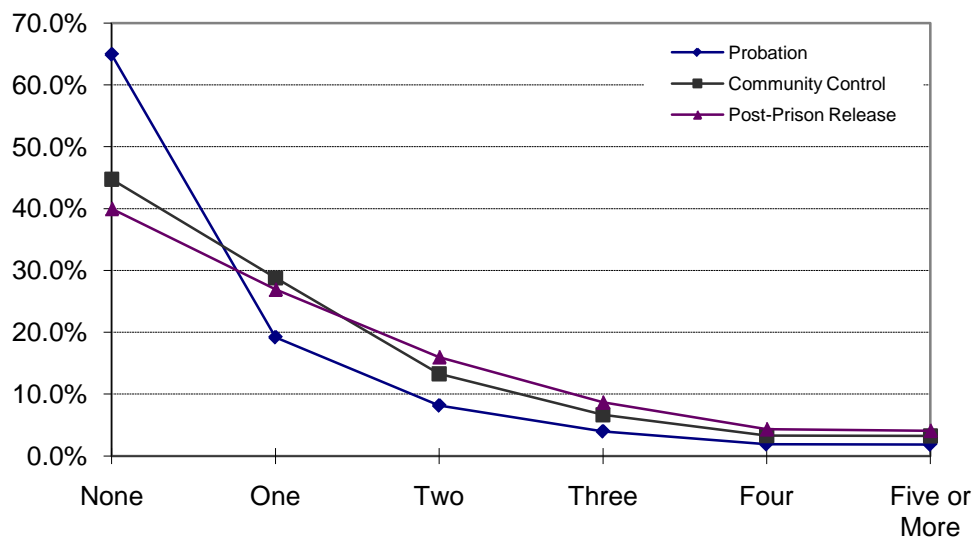
