NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE

DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS

RULE NO.: RULE TITLE:

33-601.737 Visiting – Forms

PURPOSE AND EFFECT: The purpose and effect of the proposed rulemaking is to repeal the rule and incorporate the forms into substantive visiting rules located in Chapter 33-601, F.A.C.

SUMMARY: The rule is being repealed, as the six forms incorporated are being transferred to substantive rules within Chapter 33-601, F.A.C., via rulemaking.

STATEMENT OF ESTIMATED REGULATORY COSTS: The agency has determined that these rules will not have an adverse impact on small business and are not likely to directly or indirectly increase regulatory costs by more than \$200,000 within one year of taking effect. A SERC has not been prepared by the agency. Based on the fact that the rule is being repealed only to move the forms within to different locations in substantive rules, the repeal does not affect small business or the private sector and is therefore not expected to require legislative ratification. Any person who wishes to provide information regarding the statement of estimated regulatory cost or to provide a proposal for a lower cost regulatory alternative must do so in writing within 21 days of this notice.
